Cook up a favourite hotpot meal to share. Please bring your meal in your electric crockpot or slow cooker to enable the food to be kept warm.

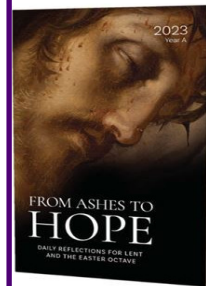
