Sacraments: Sources of Invisible Graces

Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist are the three sacraments of Initiation of the Catholic Church. God breathed the breath of Divine life into human beings while creating them in God's own image and likeness. The initiative is always with God. God invites us to share in the divine life. Those who accept this invitation through the reception of sacraments is blessed to live in relationship with God.

In the Catholic tradition, sacramental preparation for children refers to the preparation for the three sacraments of initiation along with Reconciliation. This involves religious education where children learn lessons of Catholic faith, especially about the meaning of the sacraments.

In our parish sacramental preparation is typically a weekend activity where children are introduced about the facts about the sacraments and they are oriented to deepen their faith through prayer, reflection, and active participation of the Sunday Eucharistic Celebration.

Parents and other family members play a pivotal role in sacramental preparation. They are encouraged to attend parent meetings, participate in family masses, and continue the faith formation at home. The celebration of the sacraments is the culmination of the preparation process. The entire parish community is welcomed to be part of those graceful moments of celebration although the families may choose to have additional celebrations with extended family and friends.

Thus, the time of sacramental preparation is a significant time of spiritual growth and faith journey of children. It aims to provide a strong foundation for their lifelong relationship with God and the Church.

On the previous week many of our children made their first reconciliation, also known as Confession or Penance, in preparation for the reception of sacraments. Congratulations to those children who have made their first reconciliation.

The sacrament of Reconciliation has three main components, namely contrition, confession, and satisfaction. Contrition refers to the person's genuine sorrow and remorse for their sins. Confession involves confessing one's sins to a priest, who acts as a representative of God and the Church. The priest then provides guidance and counsel to the person, and assigns a penance, which is an act of reparation to make up for the harm caused by the sin. Finally, satisfaction involves completing the assigned penance and resolving to avoid committing the same sins in the future.

The purpose of the sacrament of reconciliation is to reconcile the penitent with God and the Church, and to restore the person's spiritual relationship with God. The Catholic Church recommends that all the faithful receive the sacrament of reconciliation at least once a year, but encourages more frequent reception as part of ongoing spiritual growth and renewal, during Advent and Lent season.

May this Lenten season let us open our hearts to be reconciled with God, self, neighbour and creation.
