FEAST OF SAINT JOHN MARIA VIANNEY



Saint John Maria Vianney, also known as the Cure of Ars, was the parish priest in the small town of Ars, France during the 19th century. His feast day is celebrated on August 4th. John Vianney was canonized by Pope Pius XI in 1925. He is the patron saint of clergy throughout the world.

Despite facing challenges and difficulties, he became renowned for his exemplary pastoral work and devotion to his parishioners. His dedication to the Sacrament of Confession by spending countless hours

at the confessional offering, spiritual guidance to many and commitment to holiness and service to others serves as an inspiration to priests and believers.

His life story and virtues make him an inspiring role model not only for all Christians and for young people in a special way. His dedication to God coupled with humility, and commitment to the service of others can be a great inspiration to youth in their search for positive role models in their faith journey.

His story of becoming a priest despite numerous challenges and difficulties can be an encouragement to youth towards discernment of their vocation and to explore the possibility of serving the Church as priests or religious.

The feast day of Saint John Vianney can be integrated into the parish's youth ministry program. It can be a time for youth to gather, reflect on the saint's life, pray together, and engage in service projects, fostering a sense of community and friendship. It will be a service for youth to invite their friends or peers who may not be active in the Church to join in the celebrations.

On Saint John Vianney's feast day, the parish organize youth-focused liturgical services and prayer designed to resonate with the community's younger members that help young people connect with the saint's life and message. We had a special youth mass on 29th of July and it was a grand success. I really encourage and support all their enthusiasm and hard works for the youth ministry in our small parish family. Let us keep them in our prayers and may the patron saint's intersection guide them in the path of holiness and strong faith.

The life of Saint John Vianney can inspire young people to strive for holiness and personal growth in their faith. His example of prayer, devotion, and sacrificial service can motivate youth to deepen their relationship with God and live out their faith more authentically.
