# The Nativity of the Lord —Year B 25th December 2023

# Dear Parish Family and Friends,

### We are here today to celebrate the birth of our Saviour Jesus Christ.

What does Christmas mean to us? Often, Christmas comes and passes just by sharing gifts, singing carols, and celebrations. For some, it is sending greetings to their loved ones; for some, it is singing carols, decorations, and celebrations; while for others, it is a time of holidays and spending time with their family. Is this what Christmas is all about? Are we clenching to the true meaning of Christmas?

The Gospel of John 3:16-17 "For this is how God loved the world: he gave his only Son so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life and through him, the world might be saved" God gave His own Son Jesus Christ to us, and we all know that Jesus is the best gift from God.
