The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ — Year B 2nd June 2024

'The Holy Eucharist, Precious Body, and Precious Blood; The Bread of love is broken here, and the Cup of life is poured here.'

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi- the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The spiritual masters of the east and the west unanimously agree that life is all about fulfilment. We live and move in pursuit of this goal and this solemnity highlights the fulfilment – both physical and spiritual – that the world is searching for.

Pope Benedict XVI once in his homily during the Mass for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, said that worship of the Eucharist and its sacred nature are two interconnected aspects of the Eucharistic Mystery. He says "at the Last Supper, Jesus instituted the Sacrament of his Body and his Blood, the Memorial of his Paschal Sacrifice. By doing so, he replaced the ancient sacrifices with himself". With this faith, let us celebrate the Eucharistic Mystery today and every day and adore it as the centre of our life and the heart of the world"

The phrase "precious body, precious blood" encapsulates the profound mystery of the Eucharist and the self-giving love of Christ. It refers to the elements of the Eucharist or Holy Communion:

The consecrated bread representing the body of Christ and the consecrated wine representing the blood of Christ. During the Eucharistic celebration, we believe that the consecrated bread and wine become the actual body and blood of Jesus Christ through the process of transubstantiation. It is not merely symbolic or a metaphor; it is a real and substantial change. It invites believers to participate in the sacred feast and experience communion with the Lord Jesus, the Living spring of eternal life.

The Eucharist, the central sacrament in Christianity, symbolizes the sacrificial love of Jesus, who died on the cross for our sins and paved the way to eternal life for those who believe in Him. Jesus instituted the Eucharist during the Last Supper. The 'Feast of Corpus Christi,' or the 'Feast of the Holy Eucharist,' celebrates the real presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the elements of the Eucharist.

I am happy to congratulate 19 of our children who receives First Holy Communion on 2nd June 2024 and their family members. Receiving the Holy Eucharist for the first time is an important event in everyone's life and is considered a very holy and significant event in ones lives. I thank the family members and the parishioners for preparing the children to understand its significance and help them, while preparing for their first Holy Communion.

Dear Children, congratulations on your first Holy Communion. I pray that you may continue to grow in the light and love of the Lord Jesus, and may He shower His grace and blessing to live your most Holy life according to His will. Your faith is a beacon of hope and love that will strengthen you to welcome a blessed life while sharing the love of Jesus with the world around you.

A special note of gratitude to our parish staff and coordinators for all their hard work in supporting the families and the parish for this ceremony. Your never-ceasing support is greatly appreciated. May God bless you and your family.

WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO

Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ

Today's feast (Corpus Christi in the Latin) focuses on the Eucharist as a symbol and sacrament of unity. Although we celebrate the Eucharist every Sunday, today we pause to give special consideration to the Bread of Life nourishing our lives. When we break bread and share the one cup we recall that sacred meal between Christ and his disciples just before he sacrificed his life on the cross. We know that, like those disciples, Christ's death and resurrection has bonded us in a love relationship. For this reason, the Eucharist is never a private affair but always a call to unity. As you receive communion today, be conscious not only of Christ's presence in the Eucharistic host, but his presence in those who are receiving with you.
