### What topics will be explored at Brisbane synod?

- Embedding Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander symbols and rituals in Catholic liturgy and prayer that is liturgically and culturally appropriate.
- Authentic representation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander on committees, boards and decision-making bodies.
- How best to continue responding with transparency, justice, and compassion to the victims and survivors of sexual abuse, their families, and communities.
- Safeguarding of children and adults at risk.
- Building better relationships between parish and schools.
- Authentic engagement with the marginalised.
- Representation of women at decision-making tables at all levels of church agencies and organisations.
- New opportunities for, and formation to support, women's participation in ministries such as lector, acolyte and catechist.
- Formation for ministries such as Lector, Acolyte and Catechist and lay preaching.
- Exploration of intergenerational, cultural and ethnic diversity in formation and leadership.
- Exploration of leadership structures.
- Ecological wisdom shared by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
- Deeper understanding of Laudato Si' and integral ecology.

## HOW TO CREATE A SENSE OF COMMUNITY IN YOUR PARISH—PART 2



### 2. SMILE

The first and only interaction many people have with your parish is on Sunday. So, how parishioners greet visitors is very important. While you might train ushers in the art of community-building, it can all be undone by one negative interaction with a parishioner.

So, smile. Be joyful and friendly. Create a “Welcome Table” with helpful people who address questions and concerns. Secretaries, smile when you answer the phone!

Smile instead of grumbling. Is a noisy family sitting in front of you? Smile at them.

Has a parent climbed over you three times to take a child to the bathroom? Smile at them in a way that says, “I’m glad I’m here, and I’m glad you’re here, too.”

If that gladness doesn’t come readily, pray for it. “Jesus, remind me how blessed I am and make me a source of blessing for others.”
