Ever since the opening of the Synod on Synodality in 2021 the people of God from around the world have expressed the desire to be a church that is missionary above all by being a witness of hope to the world. Giving witness occurs in deeds and words. It requires credibility and integrity. Hence the people of God appreciate and ask to reflect on baptism from which flows a co-responsibility of all for the mission, a call to involve women and lay men in all decision making processes, the need to engage with the digital world and leaders to be held accountable. How can a synodal church unfold in a diocese and parish? What structures and processes can be envisioned to achieve being credible and effective pilgrims of hope?

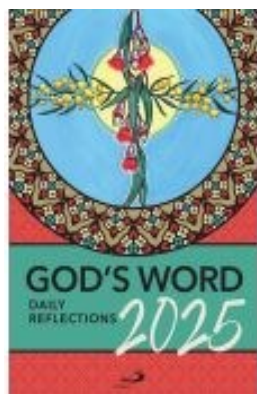

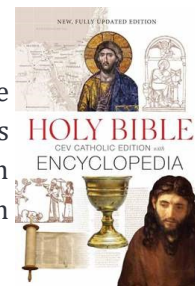
