## Fatherhood: Building Godly Foundation and Shaping the Next Generation

The first Sunday of September is celebrated as Father's Day in Australia, and its theme for 2024 is "Celebrating Fatherhood: Strength, Love, and Sacrifice." Though we are always grateful to our fathers, Father's Day allows us to celebrate them and their incredible roles in shaping our families.

Firstly, we must thank our Heavenly Father for sacrificing His one and only Son, Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of our sins to make us worthy of the eternal kingdom (John 3:16). God's sacrificial love for humanity must be the standard for the fathers' love to their children. Though we all are chosen to be God's children, He has entrusted some with the responsibilities to be earthly fathers for our children by birth, adoption, or assumed role. Like Christ being the Head of the Church, a father is the head of the family responsible for fulfilling all its needs. Fatherhood is a holy God's calling to head the family with Christ-like behavior filled with the fruit of the Holy Spirit; LOVE, JOY, PEACE, FORBEARANCE, KINDNESS, GOODNESS, FAITHFULNESS, GENTLENESS, AND SELF-CONTROL.

I express my sincere gratitude for your prayers and for being with me to fulfill my responsibilities as the spiritual father of our parish family. I do seek your continued prayers and relentless support to continue my journey in guiding and leading the parishioners as a faithful shepherd of God.

I pray and encourage that as a father you may be empowered under God's supreme power to take your roles as faithful disciples of Christ and leaders of the family to a new height in the future. I also pray for your physical and mental well-being which is vital to fulfill your diverse and challenging roles. Once again, I wish Father's Day to all fathers, and may God fill you all with His grace.


